

**ST AGNES CHURCH, CAWSTON**  
**MINUTES OF PCC MEETING**  
**HELD ON TUESDAY 8<sup>TH</sup> AUGUST 2006**

The meeting was held at The Rectory, Cawston and commenced at 7:30 p.m. with prayers led by Mrs. June Hopper.

**1. Minutes of Previous Meetings (held 6<sup>th</sup> June and 19<sup>th</sup> July 2006)**

The minutes for 6<sup>th</sup> June were agreed.

The last PCC meeting was held on 19<sup>th</sup> July, not 18<sup>th</sup> as stated in the minutes. The Harvest service will be non-Eucharistic rather than non-ecumenical as stated. The forthcoming confirmations will take place on 13<sup>th</sup> August, rather than 15<sup>th</sup> August. With these amendments the minutes were agreed by the PCC.

***Scrubbing Day***

Thanks were offered to all those that helped at the recent Scrubbing Day in church.

***Temporary Move to School***

No serious objections to the temporary move to the school have been received. Several church members have stated that they 'do not like the idea' of such a move. On this basis a four week experiment (November/December 2006) will take place. The school buildings will cost £32.96 each week.

A list of articles has been given to the church wardens to complete. A discussion was had around 'Evaluating Our Mission'.

Ideas that the PCC may wish to adopt include installing solar panels; grazing sheep in the churchyard; changing energy suppliers. It was agreed that all PCC members should have the chance to read the policy themselves. The policy will be distributed around the members.

Mrs. Bobby Ward told the meeting of plans for growth in the Sunday School. Mrs. Peggy Dewing has concerns about using the scout hut – the building is not totally suitable for use by the Sunday School.

It was proposed that the purchase of a CD/DVD player and projector be considered.
