Most of this meeting was given over to discussing the Diocese of Norwich *Committed To Growth* document. Regular PCC agenda items were held-over for the next meeting unless they were deemed urgent.

1. Urgent PCC items

Insurance cover for the next 5 years

Mrs. Rita Mead told the meeting that the annual premium for insurance was due. In the past the PCC have decided to commit to agreeing to stay with Ecclesiastical Insurance for a 5 year period in return for reduced premiums. It was decided to continue this arrangement for another 5 years.

Sunday School Future Plans

Mr. Simon Court and Mrs. Jane Court have offered to run a Sunday School on two Sundays per month.

Church/School for the Coldest Months of the Winter

Last year the PCC received a mandate from the church members that was in favour of a move to Cawston Primary School during the coldest months of winter. It is planned to do this again this winter. Initial plans are for a move to the school in January and February 2008. This will be discussed further at the November PCC meeting.

2. Committed To Growth

The whole of the rest of the PCC meeting was devoted to an in-depth discussion around the Diocese of Norwich *Committed To Growth* document. Everyone present had a copy of the diocese document which was used as a basis for the discussions that followed.

The topics under discussion were *Committed To Growth In Discipleship; In Service; and In Numbers*.

Mr. Simon Court facilitated the meeting. We were asked to rate our perception of how well St Agnes Church was performing against each of the bullet points in the document. These results were then compared; discussed; comments raised and a median score recorded (where possible).

These will be used at a future PCC meeting to decide what actions can be undertaken to improve poor scores.
