

For Teachers - Suggested uses for Photograph cards etc

- Make sets of the photograph cards so groups of children can play "Snap", "The Memory Game" (Pelmanism), etc.
- Give each child a set of cards. Teacher calls out a part of the organ and child puts a counter on corresponding card.
- Play "I spy" using A3 set of cards for phonics practise.
- During a church visit, hide cards around the church. Children have to find as many cards as possible then return to the organ to identify their card parts.
- Make a set of wordcards/ initial letter cards to go with the photograph cards for matching.
- Jigsaw picture for group or made into A4 size for individual use.
- Arrange an assortment of glass bottles of differing sizes so that the children can blow across the tops to reproduce the sound of the organ flue pipes.
